2023 Hong Kong Week themed "Hello Hong Kong"

The Hong Kong Economic and Trade Office in Toronto (HKETO) is hosting the 2023 Hong Kong Week themed "Hello Hong Kong" between end-July and end-September to feature Hong Kong's new strengths, promising economic prospects and fresh cultural vision. Activities of the 2023 Hong Kong Week include art and photo exhibitions, film festivals, musical drama performances and a national business conference to be held in different Canadian cities. 1) The "Art at Heart" Chu Tat Shing Art Exhibition in Toronto

The "Art at Heart" Chu Tat Shing Art Exhibition is the signature event of the 2023 Hong Kong Week to showcase the artworks created by Hong Kong illustrious sculptor, Mr. Chu Tat Shing, in Toronto. The exhibition will be open to the public (free admission) from August 4 to August 13 at the Chinese Cultural Centre of Greater Toronto.

Mr Chu, a highly respected artist, has left an indelible imprint on the world of art through his sculptures of iconic figures such as Bruce Lee, Dr. Sun Yat-sen, and many more. The centerpiece of the event will be the life-sized sculpture of Bruce Lee, an emblem of perseverance and discipline. This awe-inspiring piece, tailor-made for this exhibition in Toronto, revisits the dynamic sidekick posture initially created by Mr Chu for the Hong Kong Heritage Museum ten years ago. A selection of some iconic pieces will also be displayed as miniatures, allowing audiences to form a deeper connection with the vibrant culture of Hong Kong.

2) Fantasia International Film Festival 2023

The Fantasia International Film Festival 2023 is running from July 20 to August 9. HKETO co-presents the screenings of six Hong Kong films at the festival, namely:

Report on the digitalisation of financial services in Hong Kong

The Hong Kong Institute for Monetary and Financial Research, the research arm of the Hong Kong Academy of Finance, on July 12 released a new Applied Research report titled "The Digitalisation of Financial Services in Hong Kong: Recent Experience, Regulatory Developments and Considerations for Sustainable Innovation and Growth".

The report reviews market and policy factors that have accelerated the digitalisation of financial services in Hong Kong in the past few years. It also discusses the implications of digitalisation for financial inclusion and environmental sustainability, as well as the associated risks for consumers, featuring insights from local financial institutions.

In addition, the report highlights the measures implemented both in Hong Kong and internationally to mitigate the potential risks and enhance consumer protection, and it concludes with considerations for sustainable innovation and growth in the digitalisation journey for financial services in Hong Kong.

Extension of e-Channel service to non-local students, foreign domestic helpers and imported workers

The Immigration Department (ImmD) announced on July 20 that the e-Channel service will be extended to non-local students, foreign domestic helpers and imported workers with effect from July 21.

The above categories of Hong Kong residents aged 11 or above holding smart identity cards may use the Contactless e-Channel service by simply downloading the ImmD's Contactless e-Channels mobile application free of charge for enrolment using a smart phone with biometric authentication technology.

Two Hong Kong teams shine at international mathematical and physics Olympiads

Two teams of students representing Hong Kong achieved remarkable results in the 64th International Mathematical Olympiad (IMO 2023) and the 53rd International Physics Olympiad (IPhO 2023) respectively.

The IMO 2023, hosted by Japan, was held from July 2 to 13, with the participation of 618 students from 112 countries or regions. The Hong Kong team won one gold medal, one silver medal and four bronze medals.

The IPhO 2023, also hosted by Japan, was held from July 10 to 17. A total of 394 students from 82 countries or regions competed for the medals. The Hong Kong team won one gold medal, three silver medals and one bronze medal.
