The Economic Freedom of the World 2023 Annual Report (2023 Report) recently published by the Fraser Institute Hong Kong continues to rank among the top, second globally.

Among the five areas of assessment in the 2023 Report, Hong Kong continued to rank top in "Freedom to trade internationally", and third globally in "Regulation". Our scores and rankings in "Size of government" and "Sound money" also improved from those of last year.

A spokesman for the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) Government said that Hong Kong has been striving to enhance market efficiency and support, regulate enterprises in an appropriate manner, thereby leveraging the advantages of the free

# Eighth Belt and Road Summit opens in celebration of 10th anniversary of Belt and Road Initiative

The eighth Belt and Road Summit, opened on September 13 as the first fully physical edition after the resumption of normalcy, attracted nearly 6,000 representatives from Belt and Road related countries and regions, including government officials from more than 10 countries and prominent international business leaders, over 100 delegations, as well as over 35 state-owned enterprises from the Mainland, a record high over past editions. Together, the participants reviewed the development of the Belt and Road Initiative (B&RI) since 2013, and looked forward to opportunities in investment, business and trade in the next era.

With the theme "Prospering on a Decade of Collaboration", the Summit this year especially commemorates the 10th anniversary of the B&RI. Through the Summit, the HKSAR Government seeks to highlight Hong Kong's role as the functional platform for the B&RI, and to assist enterprises and professional services in exploring business opportunities, in particular those arising from emerging markets such as the Middle East and the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) markets.

## Hong Kong's Gross National Income and external primary income flows for the second quarter of 2023

Hong Kong's Gross National Income (GNI), which denotes the total income earned by Hong Kong residents from engaging in various economic activities, increased by 4.2% in the second quarter of 2023 over a year earlier to \$786.9 billion at current market prices. The Gross Domestic Product (GDP), estimated at \$707.1 billion at current market prices in the same quarter, recorded a 4.4% increase over a year earlier. The value of GNI was larger than GDP by \$79.8 billion in the second guarter of 2023, which was equivalent to 11.3% of GDP in that quarter, mainly attributable to a net inflow of investment income.


Hong Kong's total inflow of primary income, which mainly comprises investment income, estimated at \$585.2 billion in the second quarter of 2023 and equivalent to 82.8% of GDP in that quarter, recorded a significant increase of 16.1% over a year earlier. Meanwhile, total primary income outflow, estimated at \$505.4 billion in the second quarter of 2023 and equivalent to 71.5% of GDP in that quarter, also increased significantly by 18.7% over a year earlier.
