# Survey results show Hong Kong the preferred destination for enterprises to set up and expand businesses

The Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) Government announced on December 21, 2023 the results of the 2023 Annual Survey of Companies in Hong Kong with Parent Companies Located outside Hong Kong and the 2023 Startup Survey, which show that Hong Kong is the preferred destination for enterprises to set up and expand businesses.

According to the survey results, in 2023:-

- there were 9 039 companies in Hong Kong with parent companies overseas or on the Mainland China, representing a recovery to pre-pandemic high levels;
- the total number of people engaged by these companies was around 468 000;
- the number of start-ups reaching a record high of 4 257, up 272 from the previous year; and
- these start-ups engaged 16 453 persons, up by 10% compared to the previous year's figure.

Meanwhile, since its establishment in December 2022, the Office for Attracting Strategic Enterprises has attracted over 30 strategic enterprises to establish a foothold in Hong Kong. These enterprises are expected to invest a total of over HK\$30 billion in Hong Kong, and create over 10 000 employment opportunities with a majority of them being research and development or senior management positions.
